

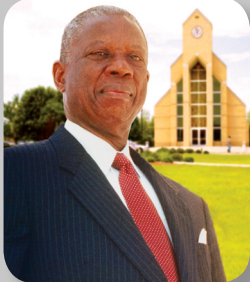

Adams to Give Commencement Convocation Address

Morris College is pleased to announce that Dr. Charles Gilchrist Adams will be the commencement speaker for the 101st Commencement Convocation to be held on Saturday, May 5, 2012 at 10 a.m. in the Sumter County Civic Center.

Well known throughout the United States and abroad, Dr. Adams received his bachelor's degree from the University of Michigan with honors and his master's degree from Harvard University, also with honors. He later went on to become a doctoral fellow at Union Theological Seminary in New York City. He has received the Rockefeller Fellowship and the Merrill Theological Fellowship, both of Harvard University.

In July of 2007, he became the first Nickerson Professor of the Practice of Ethics and Ministry at Harvard University. He has been awarded twelve honorary doctorates from such institutions as Morehouse College, Marygrove College, Dillard University and Kalamazoo College in Kalamazoo, Michigan, the University of Michigan and Morris College. His numerous awards include the "Rabbi Marvin Katzenstein Award" from the Harvard School of Divinity.

An acclaimed preacher and leader on faith-based urban revitalization, Dr. Adams is the senior pastor of Hartford Memorial Baptist Church in Detroit, Mich., where he has served since 1969.

He has served as president of the Detroit branch of the NAACP and on numerous boards in the United States, including the National Council of Churches and Morehouse College. He currently serves on the Morris College Board of Trustees.

Internationally, he has worked to combat racism around the world; addressing the United Nations and the World Congress of the Baptist World Alliance. He also accompanied Former President Bill Clinton to Jordan.

In addition to conferring approximately 142 baccalaureate degrees, President Luns C. Richardson will award eight Presidential Citations and three honorary degrees at the 2012 Commencement Convocation.
