

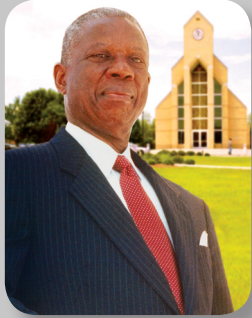

“Extensions of Ourselves”

The campus community shares “giving spirit” during college’s Fall Harvest Rally kick-off program

The warmth of giving spirits filled the Neal-Jones Auditorium as the campus community gathered on yesterday for the college’s Fall Harvest kick-off assembly.

This year’s pledges totaled \$42,979.00 of which \$16,775.00 was from faculty and staff and \$11,204.00 was from the student-body. President Richardson, in addition to the pledges made, pledged \$10,000.00 as a member of the Morris College Board of Trustees and another \$3,000.00 to be combined with faculty and staff contributions for a total of \$13,000.00. He pledged an additional combined total of \$2,000 through one

academic club and two Greek-letter organizations.

As a part of the program, the Faculty/Staff Challenge was issued by Academic Dean, Dr. Leroy Staggers, and the Student Challenge was done by the 2010-2011 SGA President, De’Siree C. Edwards. Mr. Willie Tabor, Area Development Director for the United Negro College Fund (UNCF) rendered greetings on behalf of the organization and thanked the college for its continued commitment to fundraising.

President Richardson thanked everyone for their enthusiasm and support. He went on to say, “Your gifts support a standard of excellence that goes beyond these walls.” In addition his remarks, he reminded the student-body of the upcoming mid-term examinations and encouraged them to, “...prepare yourselves to make excellent grades.”

Annually, the kick-off assembly’s dual purpose is to kick-off the Annual Fall Harvest Worship Service and Rally and to comply with the UNCF requirement that each member institution conduct an annual drive.

As indicated by Dr. Staggers, this year’s pledges epitomize that the Morris College family believes in providing, “...extensions of ourselves.”

The official Fall Harvest Worship Service and Rally, along with the parade, will be held on Saturday, November 20, 2010.

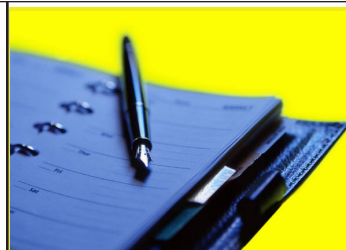
