

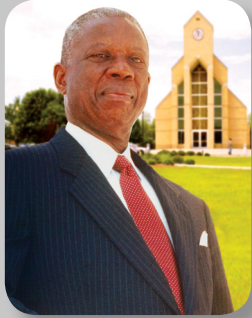

## **The Power of Being Informed**

*Reverend Cummings encourages student-body to become "well informed" during Alpha Founders' Day program*

The featured speaker was the Reverend Roderick Cummings, Sr., pastor of New Enoree Baptist Church in Newberry, SC.

The Morris College Management Institute (MCMI)-Advance Program will sponsor its assembly at 10 a.m. in the Neal-Jones Auditorium on Tuesday, November 9. The speaker will be **Mr. William Levan Byrd**, owner of William Levan Byrd, CPA, PC, a certified public accounting firm.

Byrd, a licensed Certified Public Accountant (CPA) and a Certified Management Accountant (CMA), earned a Master of Business Administration degree in accounting from Augusta State University. He has also completed further studies in taxation at New York University.

He has an extensive background in the areas of non-profit accounting and auditing, clergy taxation and church administration, strategic planning and small business consulting, employee benefits planning and administration, personal financial planning and income tax preparation and consultation. He currently serves on the Board of Directors of the South Carolina Legal Services Corporation and the Advisory Board of the Friends of the Greenhouse Shelter for Runaways.
