

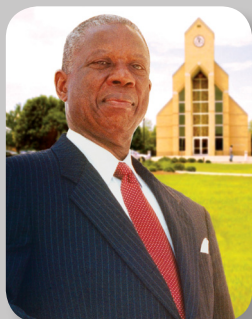

Wilson Advises Determination, Perspective and Commitment

Honor students recognized at Spring Honors Convocation.

Dr. Pamela Wilson, president of Allen University, gave an eloquent message about determination, perspective, commitment, and faith as she addressed the honor students and campus community at Thursday's Honor Convocation Assembly.

Wilson artistically and articulately crafted this message upon the backdrop of her personal story. She communicated that it is not an individual's beginning or background that determines their ability to achieve success but their determination to do so coupled with the ability to see obstacles and challenges as learning opportunities and to focus on the skills and strengths that are exhibited in the process.

She cautioned students to be humble and not judge others who choose career paths that do not require higher education. "Success is a relative term and takes on different context in different environments." She expressed that her parents were successful in supporting and providing for their family.

After sharing major challenges faced by several well-known successful individuals, including Thomas Edison, Wilson advised, "Tap into your faith, your perseverance and work ethic and you too can achieve the type of success as Edison." She also advocated, "Choose a path that works for you and mentor others after you succeed."

In his closing remarks, President Richardson described Dr. Wilson as, "A well prepared, sincere and successful person who commits to whatever she sets her hand to."

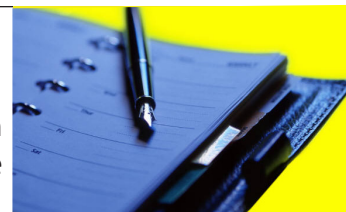
