

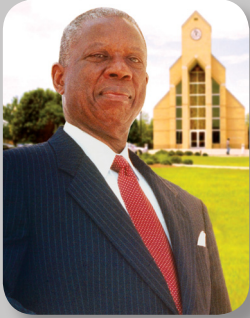

## Division Celebrates Fine Arts Week

The Division of Religion and Humanities presented a captivating and moving illustration of African-American History through music and oral presentations at the Fine Arts Assembly on Thursday, March 29, 2012.

Mr. Lorne Lee set the stage as he took the audience back in time. Sharing a vision of the capture of the African from the motherland, he was transported through the vision while hearing the undertones of the syncopated beat of the drum in modern day music. From there, he developed a rich quilt of African-American music from past to present as he introduced the division's dynamic presenters and interwove the "honey sweet sound of music."

Dr. O.T. Hill, Dr. Daniel Lackey, Dr. Marc David, and Mr. David Davis gave eloquent and unforgettable oratorical presentations that allowed the campus community to experience the Harlem Renaissance, the Civil Rights Movement, the emergence and strong role of the Black church and the Quaker's voice as abolitionist. Mr. Shawn Hair allowed us to experience worship in the Black church through a music medley worthy of praise.

Lee concluded the division's rich presentation with a challenge to Morris College students to find their voice, act as players, and take a positive role on the stage in making African-American history.

President Richardson was away from the campus attending the presidential inauguration at Allen University. In his absence, Dean Staggers gave closing remarks. He commended Dr. David for his great leadership and applauded the contributions of the division's faculty, students and staff. Staggers stated, "All the arts are powerful as they inform and transform us."

The assembly was part of a week-long celebration of fine arts, which included poetry, dance, culinary arts, a media symposium, an African-American museum on wheels and a dynamic spring concert presented by the Morris College Gospel Choir.
