

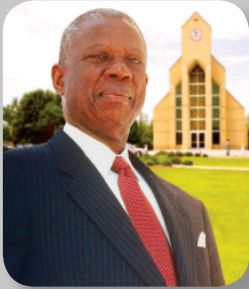

Fall Harvest Kick-off Rally Raises Excitement

The Morris College campus community was challenged by the Director of Institutional Advancement and Church Relations, Rev. Melvin Mack, "to show your love, commitment, and passion for this great institution" at the Fall Harvest Kick-off Rally Assembly on Thursday morning.

Rev. Mack explained that the Kick-off Rally begins the college's major fundraising effort, the Fall Harvest Rally, and gives the faculty, staff and students the opportunity to support a worthwhile effort. The rally also serves to meet the college's obligation to the United Negro College Fund's annual campaign drive. As a UNCF member institution, the college's UNCF fundraising goal is \$35,000. Mack stated, "We desire to exceed this goal, as we did last year."

Mack challenged the faculty and staff to appreciate the college's tremendous impact and to be proud of what it represents. SGA President, Jacques McCoy, echoed Mack's challenge, adding that student pledges are also important for others around the country, as many rely on the funds provided by UNCF. He stated, "It is in giving, that we receive."

The Kick-off Rally resulted in a total of \$22,463 in pledges. Faculty and staff pledged \$14,025 and student pledged \$8,463. Of the total pledges, \$3,250 has been received. Amounts received will be announced during the Pre-Fall Harvest Worship Service and Rally on Tuesday, November 13, 2012.

In his closing remarks, President Richardson said, "This is an occasion that calls for joviality." He went on to explain that the college has done well in showing support for the fundraising effort. He elaborated on the significance of the fundraising effort as one of the activities that offsets the college's operational cost. He also stressed the importance of the college's contributions to UNCF, having membership status since January of 1982. President Richardson serves on the general board of directors and the corporate board of UNCF. President Richardson gave the well applauded news, that his pledge will match the cash raised by faculty, staff and students.

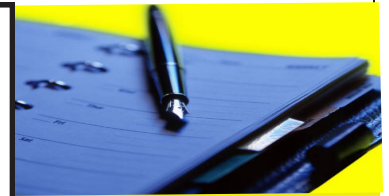
